Best Undergraduate Project Award

1. Purpose

- To encourage high-quality academic research done at the Undergraduate level
- 2. Selection method Application by student
 - The application should be submitted by the students through the Guide or the Head of the Department.
 - The deadline for nominations is **September 30**th every year.

3. Eligibility for application

- Final Year (4th year) B.E. / B.Tech /B.Sc. (Engg, Material Science, Life Science) / BPharm projects with broader relevance to Biomaterials Science. Thesis/dissertation/project reports should be completed during the academic year 2021-2022.
- The thesis evaluation should be completed at the time of application. A provisional degree will also be considered.

4. Application

- The student will apply for the award with a description of the project work in the application form available at https://biomaterials.org.in
- The application form should accompany the copy of the degree certificate endorsed by the Guide or the Head of the Department.

5. Selection Procedure

- 1st level: Initial shortlisting will be done by the Selection Committee of SBAOI.
- 2nd level: Presentation by the shortlisted candidates to the selection committee
- 3rd level: The Selection Committee will recommend the Applicant for conferment of the Award.
